#### Twin Waters West – State Confirms Planning Amendment

The State Government has released a Statement confirming that the land we know as the Canelands (Twin Waters West) is suitable to be rezoned and the Sunshine Coast Council may adopt and commence the proposed Planning Amendment to rezone the land as Emerging Community.

The State review was to ensure that state interests, such as natural hazards, impacts on state transport infrastructure and biodiversity matters are appropriately addressed and integrated within the Council's planning scheme. This review included an independent review of the flood modelling. This is the final step in the approval process for the Planning Amendment which incorporates the Conditions Precedent negotiated by the three parties - Council, Stockland and the TWRA – to ensure that, if development is to occur on the Canelands, it will be to a standard at least equal to or better than the existing Twin Waters. Stockland has announced they intend to proceed with detailed planning for a development on the site and their present intention is to submit a development application (DA) to Council by the end of this year. Council would then undertake a review and assessment of impacts of the DA and then put it out for public review. This would reasonably be expected to take place during the first half of 2019.



### A Decade Ago...

Ten years ago, back in March/April 2008, the Newsletter consisted of a single A4 sheet, with news on one side and advertisements on the other. Back then, the April Newsletter reported on the success of Clean—up Twin Waters (62 attended); Lend Lease had lodged a DA for 14 residential building blocks and two tennis courts on the existing tennis court site adjacent to the Golf Club (did not proceed) and Stockland had lodged their first proposal for the Canelands, after buying Lend Lease's interests in part of the land.

Council elections had just been held and our new Div 8 Councillor, Debbie Blumel, attended her first TWRA General Meeting on 14 April. We reported on a very wet summer in Twin Waters, with 522 mm (20 inches) recorded.

The manager of the airport addressed our February meeting in 2008 and forecast that by 2020, passenger numbers would have grown to 2 million and the new East West runway would be completed.

Looks like we might just get the new runway, at the end of 2020 (total numbers currently are still well short of 2 million). We also established the first version of a TWRA web site in 2008. Can you remember what was happening here 10 years ago?

### Twin Waters Rainfall Records

Thank you to those who responded to our request last month to share their rainfall records with us. We would like to thank Mark Garner, who was the first to respond. He gained an interest in recording rainfall over his 15 years farming Alpacas in NSW. Now living in Twin Waters, he has recorded 599 mm of rain in our suburb (YTD to mid–March). Our wettest day, so far, was 1st

February, when we had 74 mm. Historically, February and March are our wettest months.

This February we had 18 days with some rainfall and only 10 rain-free days. Our long-term March average is approximately 180 mm. So, as at mid-March (our cut-off date for printing) our rainfall YTD in Twin Waters has been quite normal.

#### Switching Email Addresses

Readers may recall that our local IT guru, Barry McMenomy, recommended we use a "universal" email address such as Gmail, iCloud, Hotmail, etc. rather than an email address from a service provider such as Bigpond or Optusnet. This enables you to easily change service providers at any time if you can get a better deal, rather than being locked in because you don't wish to change your email address. Given that the NBN is now available for connection in Twin Waters, this may be a good time to take the step to change your email address, if you want to.

There is an excellent new YouTube video by David Cox, "How to Switch Email Addresses A COMPLETE GUIDE", that can help if you need a tutorial. Incidentally, the feedback from residents who have connected to the NBN at this early stage has been very positive, with reports of Telstra download speeds in the 40 mbps range, which is excellent.
