Caring for native wildlife

WILVOS (Wildlife Volunteers) and Bat Rescue Inc. have operated on the Sunshine Coast for some 25 years and 15 years respectively, rescuing and rehabilitating sick, injured and orphaned native wildlife and ultimately releasing them back into the wild. This includes all birdlife, marsupials (possums, koalas etc.), mammals, reptiles, macropods (kangaroos, etc.) and all species of bat. Bats often get a bad rap, but they are critical in seed dispersal and the propagation of our native trees (they are very human-like and the pups are a joy to rear!). WILVOS and Bat Rescue work closely with local veterinary practices and Australia Zoo Hospital and greatly appreciate their professional assistance. Sunshine Coast Regional Council too have been a long-time supporter of WILVOS and we are grateful for their financial support. A telephone hotline operates 24/7, 365 days a year, through WILVOS – call 5441 6200 any time. We ask all members of the public to PLEASE report animals in distress to us as soon as possible – early intervention greatly improves the chance of a successful outcome. Even freshly deceased animals such as kangaroos and possums should be reported because females may be carrying live joeys in their

pouch (such as 'Nibbles' the kangaroo joey who is pictured).

New members are always welcome! Members can assist in a variety of ways – taking shifts on the hotline (we call them 'hotties'), picking up injured animals and transporting them to a vet or carer, or caring for animals during their rehabilitation. Induction training and regular workshops are provided for members and the general public. If this sounds like something you might be interested in, please contact us. It's very worthwhile and rewarding!



Please report hooning

There is a Hooning Hotline 13HOON (134666) to which you can report hooning incidents on Ocean Drive or elsewhere. If possible, get the vehicle description, rego, time and place, and nature of the incident to report it to the police. Multiple reports help establish a pattern, which may help police to track down the offenders. Keep Twin Waters safe!

TWRA is a member of the Airport Community Forum, which provides an interface between the community and airport management on current and future activities and relevant issues. Meetings are held quarterly. SCA is currently progressing with the 2019 Terminal Master Plan. It is expected the draft master plan will be exhibited for public comment early in 2019 before being referred to Council for approval. This will cover the next stage of development at the airport terminal and will be looking at the viability of expanding the International terminal, installation of aero bridges and airline lounge facilities. The next forum will be held in early July. We will keep you posted on any relevant matters.

Our fabulous public areas of Twin Waters are well maintained through a Council contract with local company "The Maintenance Company". Council staff monitor the work being done on the contract and report to both the contractor and stakeholders - including TWRA. The reports are now sent from Council every two weeks and report on all aspects of the contract work expected. Both Council and the Contractor take complaints seriously, and generally act very quickly to resolve any issues. The regular reports provide detail on gardens, weeds, tidiness and all aspects of the contract with a 1-5 marking scale. The audits mean that Council staff make regular but unannounced inspections and provide important evaluation reports and feedback on their findings. Council and the Contractor review all areas of concern. Complaints or comments from our local residents are provided to Council to ensure our high standard is maintained.

For financial members who will not be attending the AGM, a Proxy form can be lodged to have someone vote on their behalf. Proxy forms are available from the website or the Secretary and must be lodged with the Secretary prior to the start of the AGM.
