### Twin Waters West Appeal Commences

Stockland's appeal to the Planning & Environment Court over the Council's rejection of the development proposal for Twin Waters West commenced during October. The Appellant is Stockland and the Respondent is Sunshine Coast Council. There are eleven Co-Respondents. A timetable for the parties to provide information to the other parties on the basis for their respective decisions/appeals was set out for November/early December. The matter will be reviewed by Judge Rackemann (who was the presiding judge in the last P&E Court case involving Twin Waters West), on 9 December. The TWRA is not a party to the proceedings but we will monitor them and keep residents informed about significant developments.

### **State Election**

In the recent election, Fiona Simpson retained her seat as Member for Maroochydore. She has been appointed as Shadow Minister for Integrity in Government and also Shadow Minister for State Development & Planning in the new Shadow Cabinet.
