Airport Update

Lots of news regarding our airport and its services!

Jetstar is set to resume direct services from the Sunshine Coast Airport to Adelaide with 3 return services per week. This is a quarantine free service.

And Virgin has announced 4 new services per week between the Sunshine Coast and Adelaide commencing in December 2021. The airport is also keen for the year round New Zealand services to be consolidated. The airport terminal will double in size over the next 24 – 36 months in a major expansion project with all passenger touch points to be improved. Aero bridges are not part of these expansion plans.

New route priorities are MCY to Perth, with direct flights to South East Asia when the time is right.

Qantas has temporarily moved its hub from Perth to Darwin for their direct flights to

There is also talk of flights to the NT and negotiations are underway with all current airlines to commence services.

Negotiations have also commenced with the proposed new low cost carrier Bonza but any action may be 6-12 months in the future.



Ed and Merryl Berry are well known residents of Twin Waters. They have been intimately involved in our community from the moment they moved here from Maroochydore with their family in 1999. As born and bred Queenslanders, they were a rare breed! It wasn't long before, after attending a meeting of the newly formed TWRA that Ed found himself in the role of Secretary, a position he held for 8 years as well as the role of Vice President later on. In those early days, Ed and Merryl, after a TWRA meeting, would run off the minutes at the Lendlease office and walk around to distribute them to members, along with the monthly newsletter. This task was relatively easy then with far fewer houses in the community at the time! Twenty plus years on, Ed and Merryl are still very involved in community life here in Twin Waters. They still co-ordinate the distribution of the newsletter, organise Clean Up Day and, until recently, they also made up the membership cards and distributed them, welcoming new residents personally. Once Lendlease took a step back and handed it over the organisation of the Christmas Carols and the Birthday in the Park event to residents, Merryl and Ed were there to help out. Merryl is still on the Christmas Carols Committee today! Both Ed and Merryl are area co-ordinators for Neighbourhood Watch and their general contact number still rings today! In their 'spare time', Ed and Merryl are involved in the Maroochy River Golf Club, organising the Veterans and a large Golf Carnival every year. Merryl is also a volunteer with St Vincent de Paul and with Volunteers in Policing. And let's not forget the famous Twin Waters Dine-Outs where interested residents regularly visit restaurants on this side of the river with an annual visit to the TAFE College in Mooloolaba. It is clear that Ed and Merryl have always embraced and modelled the culture of knowing your neighbour and giving something back.

There is no doubt, that these two residents are indeed local legends! Along with many other people still in our area, Ed and Merryl, have selflessly contributed so much to making Twin Waters the community it is today. Thank you Ed and Merryl!

The Hearing Australia bus is stopping by at Twin Waters Pharmacy to offer free* hearing checks and raise hearing health awareness in the local community.

Healthy hearing is a big part of life. It keeps us connected to the people and life we love. Good hearing plays a significant role in helping people stay active, happy and involved in the world around them.

A hearing check is a quick and easy way to help identify if your hearing might not be as sharp as it used to be.

As well as having a hearing check, visitors to the Hearing Australia bus can also find information on how to keep their hearing in good shape and view a display of easy-to-use hearing devices for around the home. This includes headsets for watching TV and alert systems for doorbells.

No appointment is necessary. Hearing Australia will provide hearing checks to any interested adults over 18 who visit the bus on the day. The Hearing Australia team is on hand to guide you through what your next steps may be to help you rediscover the sounds you love.

*Only 15 minute hearing checks are free. Other services may attract charges/fees or may be subsidised for those eligible under the Australian Government Hearing Services Program, to which conditions apply. A hearing check is a screening that helps identify people that may have hearing loss.

Summer is (almost) here!

The unique call of the Eastern Koel, marks the arrival of summer here in Twin Waters. It arrives from FNQ and PNG around late September to early October. An excellent YouTube video by Tim Siggs, a Sunshine Coast local, provides this interesting information: "The Koel is locally called a storm bird. This is probably because they become more vocal in stormy weather. They are part of the Cuckoo family and lay their eggs in other 'host species' nest. The male looks black but in very good light, the feathers have a greenish sheen. The red eye is also prominent. The females are beautifully marked with a barred plumage. Once they have bred, most Koels head back to PNG for the winter."





Snakes are out!

With the return of the warmer weather, we also have begun to have sightings of our native fauna in the form of snakes. Residents are asked to take care as examples such as red-bellied blacks have been sighted on the golf course and near the look out area at Mudiimba Beach. The red-bellied black snake is just one of our many venomous Australian snakes. As with most snakes, they would rather not have a confrontation with a human and are relatively non-aggressive unless provoked. If you see a snake, leave it alone! Or call a company that specialises in the translocation of reptiles.

Every year, the TWRA Christmas Carols Committee donates any proceeds from the event to a local charity.
