is making into the Maroochydore–Noosa Road. This aging track stretches 28km as a 2 lane, 2-way road now used by up to 15,000 vehicles a day.

The road stretches from Ocean Street, Maroochydore to Emu Mountain Road, Peregian Springs. For Twin Waters types, it turns right after the Pacific Paradise shops, then runs past the airport. (See graphic on the right.)

## Clearing Away the Squashed – Who picks up the Road Kill?

Recently a resident complained that the Council had not been prepared to clear away road kill in front of the Ocean Drive bus stop – a possum and its baby hit by a car. The details of the situation are complicated, so we will to keep to the basics. Best number to call is: 5475 7272. The Council puts a priority on what they call 'companion animals' – cats and dogs. Those are cleared away quickly. Wildlife, such as possums, or kangaroos and wombats will be noted – but then the Council will organise a contractor to do the job. The type of road also matters. Ocean Drive is a Council road and their problem. But a bigger road like David Low Way would be the Main Roads Department responsibility. So, you would have to talk to them.
