
Next TWRA Meeting

Covenants In Twin Waters

The Twin Waters Covenants have caused some confusion, especially for newer residents. Here is a "non-legal" explanation.



The Developer Imposed Covenants were put in place by Lend Lease during development of the estate. The main purpose was to establish standards that would mark the style and character of the development and, according to Lend Lease, protect the investment of home owners in Twin Waters. There were Covenants relating to house style and finishes (e.g. 25 degrees pitch on roofs, exterior finish standards etc) and also to landscaping and standards for fences and pool fences (e.g. minimal front fences for most properties and all pool fencing to be black aluminium or glass). The Covenants are still in place and a copy can be viewed on the web site at www.twra.net (under General Information - Covenants).

Since Lend Lease completed development and left around 2005, there has been no one to administer and enforce the Developer Covenants. The Council has made it very clear that they will not enforce Developer Covenants. This has been requested on several occasions. The only option, therefore, is to rely on the community to "do the right thing" and maintain the Covenants.

There is no question that the Developer Covenants were of value in establishing the higher standards that prevail here. We all benefit from this. All we can request now is that all residents take the time to become informed about these Covenants and do their best to make sure that they are followed, especially if you are adding to your property, building a pool, fences or other landscaping.

There were also Covenant conditions relating to parking of boats, caravans and vehicles in front yards or on footpaths etc. Together, this makes Twin Waters a better place for everyone. The TWRA cannot be involved in any way with covenant enforcement and all we can ask is that everyone "do the right thing".




Good Neighbours – There For Each Other

Optus Mobile

TWRA has been advised that Optus Mobile will be commencing with two additional mobile towers to improve the overall mobile coverage and broadband coverage into Twin Waters.

- 1. A new tower next to the Telstra tower at the old Motorway Toll Booth Building abutting the motorway and just south of the turn off is still in the DA process but expected to be up and running by November.
- 2. Collocating on the new Telstra Tower, recently built in the bushes behind the Apex Club and near the Maintenance Building to the Novotel Resort, should be installed towards the end of October.

At present, Optus coverage is serviced by their facility on the roof of Banyandah Towers in Maroochydore and the phone tower near the Control Tower at the Airport which was adequate 5 years ago but not now. This information should be of great interest to those residents who presently experience below standard mobile and broadband coverage.
