All this work is necessary so as Lend Lease can hand the lake and the responsibility for the maintenance back to the council.

# Settlers Park Interpretive Sign – Appreciating Our Heritage

There is a new interpretive sign at Settlers Park, the small park in Pacific Paradise, adjacent to the entry to Twin Waters at the corner of David Low Way and Ocean Drive. This unique interpretive sign, documenting the history of the area, will be a key feature of the master plan for the park.

The sign was developed with strong community input

– including contributions from the students of Pacific Paradise State School – under the watchful eye and guiding hand of designing artist, Margaret Worthington. Local historian Benny Alcorn played a major role by contributing her knowledge of local history to a timeline featured on the sign.

The park is largely undeveloped and contains four heritage-listed

mango trees which may be over 100 years old and planted by the first European settlers.

# Easy Cooking - Warwick's 'Carols' Muffins


At regular meetings to plan the Twin Waters Carols I have managed to rise early to cook muffins for our morning refreshment. For those 'many devotees' here is my recipe.

# Works Being Undertaken In Twin Waters

#### **Twin Waters Drive**

The reinstatement of the pathway and removal of sandbags from the kerb edge is under way. Pavers have now been re-laid and all work should be completed by end May.

#### **Boat Ramp Gate**

During the Easter period, the gate at Water Gallery boat ramp was open whereby the padlock was closed on the chain, but the chain was not fastened to the post. A replacement lock was fitted but on inspection, it was still unsatisfactory. Council has now fitted a new 'tamper proof' system.

#### Water Works

Some residents will have noticed a barricaded section of pathway down Ocean Drive, east of Novotel, following the discovery of a water leakage. A new isolating valve has been installed in the pipeline and finishing off work is under way.
