Speed Limits & Signage

Thank you to everyone who responded to our request for community views about the speed limits in Twin Waters. There was a good response.

Most people favoured a single speed limit within Twin Waters of 40 kph, with much more signage, including painting speed limits on the road, similar to the new bikeway signs on Ocean Drive. Much concern was expressed about speeding and the obvious safety risks.

Quite a few people wanted uniformity with general Queensland residential speed limits of 50 kph (unless otherwise signed) so that there would be no confusion for visitors and to minimize signage in our streets. A small number favoured a mix of 40 and 50 kph limits.

We have written to Council requesting that their Road Safety officers review the speed limits and signage within Twin Waters taking into account the expressed community views. We have also taken the opportunity to thank Council for the recent upgrade to Ocean Drive.

Covenants In Twin Waters

The Twin Waters coastal community is a fully planned residential community that is highly regarded both locally, nationally & internationally ("World's Best Address" 2004).

A major influence in this success was the introduction of Covenant and Residential Building Guidelines to encourage both good design and a high standard of housing that exists within the community today. We encourage residents to continue to uphold and maintain these guidelines (i.e. renovations, garages, storage, fencing, landscaping, etc) to ensure that the high level of amenity established within the community is maintained.

There were also Covenant conditions relating to parking of boats, caravans and vehicles in front yards or on footpaths etc. Together, this makes Twin Waters a better place for everyone. The TWRA cannot be involved in any way with covenant enforcement and all we can ask is that everyone "do the right thing".

The Covenants are still in place and a copy can be viewed on the web site at www.twra.net (under General Information -Covenants).

New Swimming Pool Fencing Laws

n the 1st December 2010, the Queensland Government introduced new laws in an effort to reduce the number of deaths of children in Queensland by drowning. If you have a swimming pool, then these new laws directly affect you. You must ensure your pool complies with the new pool safety standard by no later than 30th November 2015.

If you sell your property before that date, then either you or the buyer will need to ensure the pool complies, by no later than 90 days from the settlement date. If your lease or rent out your property after the 8th July 2011, or renew a lease after that date,

it is essential that your pool complies with the new standard and that you obtain a pool safety certificate.

You can contact one of many pool safety inspectors who will attend your property for a fee (usually between \$200 and \$300) to advise if your pool fencing complies or not. If your fencing does not comply, you will receive a Non-Conformity Notice. This notice will detail work to be done by you prior to the inspector re-inspecting the fence (for an additional fee).

When compliant, a Pool Safety Certificate will issue to you and be lodged by the inspector with the Queensland Government so that it can be seen on the public register of pool safety certificates.

2011 Half-Year Rainfall in Twin Waters

he total rainfall for the first six months of 2011 from 1st January to 30th June was 1362 mm. This compares with our five-year average of 1235 mm. Our wettest month was January with 474 mm and the wettest day was January 11th when we had 157 mm. The driest month was June, with only 42 mm. So, despite the floods in SEQ in January, we had a fairly normal six-month rainfall pattern. Thank you to Len Gamble for these local rainfall stats.

Easy Cooking

Florentines

½ cup (80g) sultanas

2 cups (60g) corn flakes

34 cup (105g) slivered almonds, chopped coarsely

½ cup (105g) glace' cherries, chopped finely 2 tablespoons finely chopped glace' ginger 2/3 cup (160ml) sweetened condensed milk 250g dark chocolate, melted.

Preheat oven to moderate. Combine all ingredients (exclude chocolate) in large bowl.

Drop rounded teaspoons of mixture about 2cm apart on baking-paper-lined oven trays and bake in oven about 10 minutes or until browned; cool on trays.

Spread base of each Florentine with chocolate. Make wavy lines in chocolate with fork just before chocolate sets.
