New Pathway

The Department of Transport and Main Roads advises that work is due to commence on the construction of the new Pacific Paradise shared pedestrian and cycle path on the Sunshine Motorway.

The 2.3km pathway between the Maroochy River Bridge and Ocean Drive on David Low Way is a vital connection between existing cycles and pedestrian facilities and has been eagerly awaited by North Shore residents.

Work is scheduled to start in late October and is due for completion in early 2012, weather permitting.

Residents may experience some disruption during construction, although the majority of work will be undertaken between 6am and 6pm, Monday to Friday, with the possibility of some weekend work.

Turtles Need A Home

Quite by chance in the 1980s, I bought a carved, wooden turtle when I was in Vanuatu; I now have about forty five of them, each with its unique reason for being. It's an interesting "hobby" because everywhere I travel it gives me a purpose to be there. I seek out turtles in little shops, markets, galleries, roadside stalls and anywhere else appropriate to my quest. The turtles have also been of assistance to my friends and family, for they now have an easy option for gifts and know that they will not be returned or replaced.

Each of my forty five little turtles has its own story, but what intrigues me most are the different shapes, sizes and substances that constitute each of these objects. Two of my most treasured pieces were a gift and are from "The DeRosa, families collection", which are hand-carved and hand-painted ceramic pieces, decorated with platinum, 18 karat gold and enamel glazes, from Montevideo, Uruguay. Other favourites are crafted from jade, opal stone, soap stone, Venetian glass, Swarovski crystal and pewter, to name but a few. The more realistic pieces were carved by locals in Papua New Guinea, Hawaii, Pitcairn Island, Australia and Fiji out of local timbers. The objects are delightful and each tells its own story through the colours and grain of the timber and the attention to detail by the carver.

Seeking out objects like this creates many stories, the most amusing of which comes from Hawaii, where an over enthusiastic merchant wanted to sell me all of the turtle ornaments in his shop. I bought most of them but balked when he showed me a fluorescent turtle. There it was, grossly green

lying on its stomach looking up at me with its green and lifeless turtle eyes. "No" I said, "Not that!" "But Madam", he said, "It is truly beautiful, come I will show you", and before I knew it, my travelling companion and I were shoved into a very dark and tiny store-room with the little man breathing down my front all hot and sweaty, and the little green turtle glowing beautifully in the dark – I bought it!



My treasured collection needs a home so if there is anyone out there who is a cabinet maker and can make me a display cabinet for my collection please let me know.
