Lake View Drive Bridge

Youths and even younger persons are jumping from this Bridge. Please ensure that your children are aware that this is irresponsible and can cause serious alteration to their life's circumstances. The water is not as deep as it looks! Spine and neck damage can leave them incapacitated for life. Coolum Police has advised us to ring PoliceLink on 13 14 44 or the Council Call Centre on 5475 8501 if you see this occurring.

New Flags For Patrolled Beaches

Changes at the local beaches now see that the red and yellow flags are now joined by black and white quartered flags replacing the blue ones.

Always remember to swim between the red and yellow flags and where there are no flags, it means 'no swim'.

The new black and white quartered flags indicate where the 'keep clear zone' (buffer zone) finishes. The buffer zone is there to ensure no overlap occurs between surf craft and swimmers.

If lifeguards and lifesavers can't see you, they can't save you.



- Swim between the red and yellow flags which indicate the supervised swimming area.
- Remember: No flags = No swim
- Look for, read and obey water safety signs
 Check swimming conditions and the water depth before swimming - never dive head first
- Swim under supervision or swim with a mate never go in alone
- Never swim directly after eating or under the influence of drugs and alcohol
- Learn how to recognize rips and keep clear of these areas. If caught in difficulty stay calm, float with the current and call out HELP and wave an arm if help is nearby
- AND REMEMBER when in the sun always SLIP, SLOP, SLAP, SLURP and WRAP (slip on a shirt or rashie, slop on sunscreen to protect exposed skin, slap on a hat, drink water, and wear sunglasses with a hat when not swimming)

Dog Litter

Please be considerate when walking your dog. Pick up your dog's litter and dispose of correctly. Increased sightings and mishaps are occurring.

Easy Cooking – Fantastic Figs

8 figs, split lengthways
100g melted butter
Zest & juice of 1 orange (no white pith)
50ml Cointreau (optional)
2 tablespoons honey
3 tablespoons walnuts – roughly chopped
Vanilla ice-cream

Place the figs split-side up in small baking dish so that they fit snugly. Pour over the melted butter and toss to coat the figs completely. Combine the orange juice, zest, honey and Cointreau. Pour over figs then scatter the walnuts evenly over the top. Bake for 30 minutes in pre-heated oven (180°C) basting every 10 minutes. Serve with icecream.

here has been a rise in the number of phone and email scams targeting Australians in recent times. The scammers have identified certain organisations they believe are trusted throughout the community such as your bank, the Australian Tax Office and even charities. In 2011 over \$70 million was netted by various scamming techniques.

How to identify a scam phone call:

- you are contacted out of the blue
- be alert and aware
- you are not expecting the money or know nothing of the scheme

What to do if you are not sure the call is a scam:

Chances are it is a scam, but to be sure, there is a simple way to find out.

- Ask the caller for their name, department and which contact number from the website you need to call to talk to them again.
- Never use the phone number provided, through alwavs go the switchboard on the website. - Type keywords relating to the call and the word 'scam' into a search engine such as Google. For example: '\$7000 ATO Grant Scam'. Looking through the top ten results will give you a clear indication of what is occurring.

How do I report a scam and will it help?

If you are the target of a scam, it is VERY important to pass on to the Federal Government Scamwatch program www.scamwatch.gov.au all of the details you have collected about the caller, the names used, what they were offering and any contact information you were provided with.
