Next TWRA Meeting & Candidates Forum

The next TWRA Meeting will be held in the Mudjimba Room at the Novotel Resort, Twin Waters on Monday, 23 April 2012 at 7.30pm.

Direct New Zealand flights from SC Airport

Sunshine Coast Airport has announced that direct flights to/from New Zealand will commence in July for a threemonth trial period. Air New Zealand will operate two flights a week to and from Auckland direct into the Sunshine Coast.

This is very good news for the Sunshine Coast. It is only a trial so it is in our interests to support the service as much as possible. Invite your NZ rellies and friends over here or why not plan to go over there for a skiing holiday or to transit through Auckland to "the world"?

We want a permanent link to be established so we must all do what we can to support this trial. (Air New Zealand has a code share arrangement with Virgin Australia so bookings can be made through the websites for either airline or through your travel agent).

Energex Pacific Paradise Substation

The site preparation for the proposed Pacific Paradise Substation near the Sunshine Motorway has been completed. The site has been over-filled to assist compaction for the foundations.

The construction timeline is for the station to be operational by the summer of 2014/15 to cater for electricity demand growth on the North Shore. Actual site construction will not commence for a few months. The buildings are scheduled to be completed by mid 2013 with the equipment fitout to take a further 6-8 months. The substation will be supplied by a 132 kV power line (on poles, not towers) entering from the west-side.

If you would like to see what the final substation will look like, there is a similar 132/11KV substation at Currimundi on Creekside Bvd near Snapdragon St, Currimundi (UBD ref. 100 B1). We will continue to keep you advised.

Spot the Pothole

The heavy rain may have left the Sunshine Coast, but potholes are now appearing on roads around the region. The Sunshine Coast Council is committed to repairing the damage and Civil Works Services Manager, John Netherton, said locals could also help by letting us know where problems are located.

You can call Customer Service on 5475 7272 or visit the Council's website and fill in a quick and easy online form. When completing the online form, residents are urged to provide as much information as possible to assist Council in identifying the location and urgency of the work required. Council will prioritize any items reported and work with the Department of Transport and Main Roads to repair potholes on local and State Government controlled roads.

Supporting Talking at Pacific Paradise State School – Help Needed!

f you have a few hours to spare each week, why not help out in Prep at Pacific Paradise State School?

The program called Supporta-Talker is designed to provide children experiencing language delays the opportunity to interact regularly with a supportive adult to enhance the child's language learning and get them ready for the reading and writing process.

Support A Talker (SAT) is a school oral language programme for prep students. Volunteer tutors facilitate oral practice through language games and activities in four areas including conversation, talking about books and playing barrier games and oral language games (which assist vocabulary, grammar and language effectiveness). Selected students attend two or three 30 minute sessions per week with tutors.

Volunteers attend two training sessions at Pacific Paradise State School to learn how to support students talking at school. The school will pay for your blue card enabling you to work with students.

Sue Walsh, the school's Speech-Language Pathologist said "There is strong evidence to show that the children who come to school with good vocabulary, grammar and knowledge of how language works are more successful in literacy, learning and social interactions. At Pacific Paradise SS we are committed to giving our students the best start possible in these important areas." Gail Chalmers is the school-based coordinator who supports the tutors to implement the programs.


