Waterways Structure Update

he SCRC has advised that a Standard Terms/ Lease Document has been developed which outlines the terms and conditions that need to be followed with respect to pontoon/structures on the Twin Waters lake/waterways. (A copy has been posted on TWRA website.) SCRC has also advised that the independent valuation for proposed lease fees has been completed. Both the Standard Terms/ Lease content and proposed lease fees are subject to endorsement/ratification at next full Council meeting this month. Your sub-committee is planning to meet with both Lend Lease and SCRC to review all major matters and concerns prior to Council meeting.

Safe Waterways

Areminder to canoeists, paddle-boarders, fishermen and all – the shark is STILL in our waterways. It has been sighted recently on the west side of Karinya Island and south of the bridge onto the island and again at entrance to the weir where people have been standing waist deep fishing and their children and dog paddling. It is a bull shark and appears to be about a metre in length.

In checking with 'those in the know' I am advised that young sharks who have been guided by their mother through feeding areas when very young, when fending for themselves as teenagers are not fully aware of what is on their diet and are likely to have a bite first to determine if it's of their liking. Be aware!

Dogs and Beaches

here is some concern about dogs disturbing migratory birds around the river mouth. The discussion has been prompted by an article in the Sunshine Coast Daily on December 22nd. It is clear that many people from Twin Waters use this area on a regular basis. We want to ensure that the views of our community are given due consideration. Cr Jason O'Pray said in The Sunshine Coast Daily on January 11th and in further communication with TWRA that Maroochy North Shore off-leash beach won't go.

Dogs in Twin Waters

We have no "Dogs-Off-Leash" areas in Twin Waters and have no suitable areas for making one. This has been considered a number of times over the years and we do not envisage that any circumstances have changed here. The Maroochy North Shore area is our closest such area.

While we're on the doggie subject: in walking around our beautifully landscaped street ways and parks it is obvious that some dog walkers are not cleaning up after their beloved pets. Remember it is the law.

Twin Waters – an Estuarine Village

There are a number of reasons why Twin Waters is the jewel of the Maroochydore coastline, the most prominent is of course its ties with the ocean. Twin Waters and its beautiful waterways are not only a fantastic playground and

spectacular backdrop but they are our gateway to the Pacific and all its life.

The estuaries of Twin Waters are in fact vitally important marine environments and havens for marine biodiversity. But what is a marine estuary, why are they so important and what roles do we play in protecting them?

An estuary is simply a waterway that provides a transition between the sea, the land and the fresh water which flows from it. But they are more than that - they are havens for life and naturally rich with biodiversity and life.

Estuaries are vital habitats for many varieties of marine species and are often called "the nurseries of the sea". They are protected environments and abundant in food, providing an ideal location for fish and shellfish to reproduce.

Over the next few editions of the Twin Waters Residents' Newsletter a Project Support Office from the Salinity and Water Quality Alliance is going to introduce us to our estuarine environment and some of the animals that call it home. We will look at the simple things that we can all do to protect their homes and protect our own back yards.

Boardriders History Makes Waves

New book on the market as from February 2 "should've been here yesterday" outlines the history of North Shore Boardriders 1969-79. Outlined in this book are the foundation years of the Club and is the first in a series compiled by Kristen Jones, (mother of professional surfing star Nic Jones) and designed by Twin Waters graphic designer Steve Sturgess and University of Sunshine Coast tutor Max Hornibrook.

It takes us from the birth of the Club when a group of surfers from Redcliffe travelled every weekend to surf the beaches from Caloundra to Noosa – and camped and surfed many times at the north shore during their sojourns out of Brisbane. Maroochy's North Shore was part of the

Centenary Bonsai Collection

o mark the centenary of the declaration of Canberra as the National Capital, the National Bonsai and Penjing Collection of Australia is conducting a competition for the best bonsai in Australia. This competition will be conducted each decade until the bicentennial in 2113.

Twin Waters resident Margaret Roberson, has been selected as one of three Queenslanders to display a tree in this collection which will be housed in the First Garden of the Canberra International Arboretum and Garden. The display will be officially opened on Saturday 2nd February after the judging by two Australian and one International Bonsai artist. Margaret is a member of the Sunshine Coast Bonsai Society Club which meets every fourth Saturday from February to October at the Woombye Community Arts Hall.

Margaret's tree is a 56 year old Ligustrum lucidum, a native of China. A tree of this type usually reaches 12 metres in height. Her 50cm high tree was styled on the famous Anthony Horden Tree which was located on the Razorback Mountain just outside Sydney. The Anthony Horden family crest carried the words "while I live I grow". Sydneysiders may remember this tree which was made famous by the truckies blockade in the 70's. This tree was then poisoned and soon afterwards the company went out of business. But a bonsai version lives on.

Twin Waters Rainfall 2012

hether the weather be cold, or whether the weather be hot, we'll weather the weather whatever the weather whether we like it or not".

We may think last year was dry, but in fact our total annual rainfall in 2012 was 2052mm, which is almost the average we have had over the past five years of 2060mm. The problem was that 2012 was a year of two halves - wet and dry!

Our wettest month was March, when we had 582mm and our wettest day was March 23rd when 203mm of rain fell. There were 14 wet days in March. In August, not a drop fell, the first time in 5 years when we had a month with no rain at all.

In December we had only 40mm of rain compared to 289mm in December 2011. Even Twin Waters is a land of contrasts! Thank you to Len Gamble for providing these Twin Waters rainfall stats.
