# Stockland Appeal Concludes

The appeal in the Planning & Environment Court by Stockland against Council's rejection of their proposals for re-zoning of the Canelands was concluded on 6th March. The judge reserved his decision. It will be announced on a date to be advised, expected to be between one and three months from the end of the hearing.

Representatives from the TWRA attended most of the sessions during the hearing. We were impressed by the incisive questioning of the various experts by the judge and we considered the Council's and wider community's interests were well represented by their legal team.

As reported last month, the appeal focused in 5 areas – visual amenity, need, hydrology, good quality agricultural land and town planning. Experts for both Council and Stockland in all these areas were the subject of detailed examination and cross examination by the barristers for the parties.

It is impossible to predict the decision and when the judgement is made TWRA members will be advised by email immediately.

## Ironman 70.3

The Sunshine Coast is building on its superb reputation as a world class sporting event destination with the announcement of the inaugural IRONMAN 70.3 to be held in Mooloolaba on 15 September 2013.

This is great news for tourism operators and local businesses looking to gain in excess of \$3 million each year for the next three years that the event is scheduled to run here. The 70.3 is the fastest growing triathlon series in the world and this event fits in perfectly along with the hugely popular Noosa, Mooloolaba and Caloundra Triathlons and the Sunshine Coast Marathon.

Tourism and Events Queensland have worked closely with the Sunshine Coast Council to secure this event for the Sunshine Coast. It is anticipated that this event will generate an additional 20,000 visitor nights a year for the Coast as well as giving us the opportunity to showcase our very special part of the world to the international tourism market. # Building Community Awareness

A team of Creative Advertising students from the University of the Sunshine Coast are engaged in the creation of a communications campaign to raise community and brand awareness for Katie Rose Cottage, a hospice operated by the Sunshine Coast Community Hospice. Located on 14 beautiful acres just off Noosa/Eumundi Road in Doonan, Katie Rose Cottage offers a community palliative care nursing service for the Sunshine Coast and surrounding areas. They provide support with physical, psychological, social and spiritual issues, offering comfort, peace and dignity at the end of life for their guests.

While hospices are well established in the United Kingdom and in New Zealand, the concept of the hospice is relatively new to Australia and is largely unknown in terms of what such a facility provides. The challenge for the University student advertising team is to both raise awareness of the hospice and to encourage involvement by the business and broader community by way of financial support and contributions, as well as encouraging volunteers to help out.

The Twin Waters community is already very involved with Katie Rose Cottage. Through the generosity of the members of our

community and the Twin Waters Residents' Association, proceeds from last year's Twin Waters Birthday Party were donated to the hospice. It is planned that the communication campaign being developed by the USC student team will extend community awareness and generosity beyond the bounds of Twin Waters to encompass all the residents of the Sunshine Coast.

#### Bus Service to End

It has been announced that Translink has carried out a review of bus services in South East Queensland. The review showed that often fewer than seven people used the Twin Waters/Maroochydore 613 service. Because of low numbers it has been decided that the service is not viable and will be discontinued in the middle of the year. This decision may be reviewed in the future if the demand for public transport in the area increases.
