#### May's Solar Eclipse

An annular solar eclipse will take place on May 10, 2013, with a magnitude of 0.9544. A solar eclipse occurs when the Moon passes between Earth and the Sun, thereby totally or partially obscuring the image of the Sun for a viewer on Earth. An annular solar eclipse occurs when the Moon's apparent diameter is smaller than the Sun, causing the Sun to look like an annulus (ring), blocking most of the Sun's light. Can be widely viewed in Australia.

#### Happy Mother's Day

The earliest history of Mother's Day dates back to the ancient annual spring festival the Greeks dedicated to maternal goddesses. The Greeks used the occasion to honour Rhea, wife of Cronus and the mother of many deities of Greek mythology.

Ancient Romans. too. celebrated a spring festival, called Hilaria dedicated to Cybele, a mother goddess. Ceremonies in honour of Cybele began some 250 years before Christ was born. The celebration made on the Ides of March by making offerings in the temple of Cybele lasted for three days and included parades, games and masquerades. The celebrations were notorious enough that followers of Cybele were banished from Rome. (The Ides of March marks the day that Caesar was assassinated.)

Early Christians celebrated a Mother's Day of sorts during the festival on the fourth Sunday of Lent in honour of the Virgin Mary, the Mother of Christ.

In England the holiday was expanded to include all mothers. It was then called Mothering Sunday. We continue to celebrate Mother's Day just because we love them.

#### International Star Wars Day

Excuse the pun but this is serious - 4th May this is celebrated. Get it? "May the fourth be with you" Hire the movies! And sit back and eat space food.

And on that subject, one of John Glenn's many tasks, as the first American to orbit Earth in 1962, was to experiment with eating in weightless conditions. Some experts had been concerned that weightlessness would impair swallowing. Glenn experienced no difficulties and it was determined that microgravity did not affect the natural swallowing process.

The food sachets were held onto the travs by Velcro. The crew of Gemini III sneaked a corned beef sandwich on their spaceflight as it was a favourite of Mission Commander Gus Grissom. Floating pieces of bread posed a potential problem, causing Grissom to put the sandwich away and the astronauts were mildly rebuked by NASA for the act. A congressional hearing was called and NASA took special care about what astronauts brought along on future missions.

Do you regularly send packages to friends and family in the UK? Now, because Australia is not a member of the EU the recipient will have to pay a European import duty plus a further 8 Pounds Stirling handling charge.

Note that customs charges are applied to imports into the EU with a value over 15 Pounds; Items valued over 135 Pounds will attract import duty and imported gifts over 40 Pounds between individuals will attract VAT.
