Bus Shelters in Ocean Drive

The committee first approached the council to have bus shelters erected along Ocean Drive. The primary purpose of the shelters was to provide shelter to children waiting for school buses. At the time it was thought that this could be combined with also providing shelter at the Maroochydore bus service stops.

You have been advised that the bus service is to cease from mid year but we are still pressing ahead for bus shelters for school children. Unfortunately this project seems to have been put on the backburner but we are assured that funds will be available for this to go ahead in the near future. We will let you know what develops.

Kayak Launching Ramps

We have approached the council requesting that they install four additional kayak launching ramps at the eastern end of the Twin Waters waterways.

This approach was originally made in 2010 but didn't progress due to the pressures following council amalgamations. All the current ramps are toward the lake end of the waterways. We have requested two ramps on either side near the Ocean Drive bridge and another two along Prestwick Drive.

We will keep you advised as to the outcome of our discussions with council.

Proposed Men's Shed for Mudjimba

The North Shore Lions Club are trying to obtain from Council the use of the old Rural Fire Brigade Shed in Greenwood Street Mudjimba to set up a Men's Shed. We have been pleased to give our support to them and look forward to the development which could be enjoyed by Twin Waters residents.

Gardening in June

Tasks: Plant roses, deciduous trees, shrubs and frangipani cuttings. Prune roses, deciduous plants and swollen gall wasp stems on citrus. Relocate poorly positioned trees and shrubs to new areas. Control carrot-like bindii weed in lawns to avoid painful burrs during summer. Fertilise citrus, passionfruit, native plants and emerging bulbs, then water well. Subtropical: calendula, cornflower, dianthus, kale, lobelia, nemesia, pansy, phlox, statice, strawflower & viola, beetroot, broad beans, broccoli, cabbage, capsicum, celery, endive, French beans, garlic, leeks, onions, parsnip, peas, potatoes, silver beet, spinach, swede, sweet potato & tomato.
