Bus Shelters - Feedback Needed

We have had a project going for some time to have at least one bus shelter erected in Ocean Drive to provide refuge in adverse weather for school children. At one stage we thought that this could be a shelter to be used by commuter bus patrons as well as school children but, as you are probably aware, the bus service to Maroochydore is to end shortly because of lack of patronage.

We have liaised with council officers and looked at the pickup points for children in Ocean Drive. It appears that the two major pick up points are just north of the Twin Waters Drive roundabout and at the existing bus shelter west of Wattlebird Drive. Lesser numbers are picked up opposite the Twin Waters Shopping Village and at the bus stop just south of the Prestwick Drive roundabout.

The problem for the council with the area near Twin Waters Drive is that it would cost in the vicinity of \$50/60,000 to build a bus shelter there. The regulations under which the council operates mean that they would have to build up the area off the

existing bitumen road surface so as an extended bitumen apron could be built. The area for the bus shelter would also have to be built up because the regulations state that disabled access has to be provided. We are told that a shelter cannot be built unless these conditions are met. At this cost council would not build a shelter.

The alternative site suggested by council is at the bus stop just south of the Prestwick Drive roundabout. This is about 250 metres from the Twin Waters Drive site. At that location there is already extended bitumen and the surface is more level and would require less building up. There is also sufficient area off the roadway where parents can park and drop off their children. A bus shelter at that site would probably be affordable.

We need feedback, in particular from parents of school children, as to whether they and their children would use the bus shelter if one is built near Prestwick Drive.

Bicycle Riders Note

y the end of this year exemptions will be In place so that anyone wearing religious headdresses can ride a bike in Queensland without a helmet on.

Studies conducted in Queensland show that those wearing a helmet have a 69% reduction in the likelihood of brain injury when involved in a bike crash. Wearing helmet remains compulsory any other cyclists who don't have an exemption, with the penalty for failing to wear a helmet while riding a bicycle being a \$110 on-the-spot fine.

According to CARRS (Centre for Accident Research & Road Safety Qld), each year an average of 35 Australian cyclists are killed and over 2500 are seriously injured.

It is timely that we be aware of the associated dangers that exist. There are 33 rules for bike riders so if you are just starting out, have children riding or need to brush up on these you might like to refer to www.tmr. gld.gov.au/Safety/Queensland-Road-Rules/ Bicycle-rules.asp
