occupancy coming from New Zealand, and are quite low going to New Zealand. But with an increase of the period of these flights, income is expected to go from \$14 million to \$19 million.

Work on the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) on airport expansion has been progressing well and should be released for a statutory 30 business day public comment period in early 2014. A copy of the EIS can be viewed where formal comments can be submitted which would then be taken into consideration.

The issue of the noisy small plane was raised by TWRA and representatives from other organisations, which was generally considered to be way over the top with noise. Apparently the plane was carrying out aerobatic certification, but should have been flying over the canefields and not houses. But, the plane is allowed to fly during tower hours, being 8.00am to 7.00pm. Peter Pallot, the airport's general Manager, has promised to follow up with the operator and as well AirServices Australia will also get involved following so many complaints. AirServices Australia representative did say there were less controls involved with small aircraft than with the larger commercial aircraft.

Mike Becker was unable to attend the meeting to discuss complaints concerning his helicopter business, as he was in Sydney collecting the 2013 Telstra Australian Business Award for a medium size business (which is a significant achievement congratulations!). When he and his wife were returning from Sydney, they happened to sit next to our very own Geoff Billard, who naturally but nicely, raised the noise problems associated with his business.

Mike is acutely aware of the ongoing concerns and informed Geoff he has tried just about everything he can do, especially with routing of flights and training away from populated areas. However, some training with instruments must be undertaken near the airport and flight paths and there is no alternative to some noise and disruption, which they do try to minimise. The business has grown since being established in 1995 and is an important contributor to the general economy of our region, including the employment of some 80 specialised staff, some of whom live in Twin Waters. 
Daylight Saving Not For Queensland?

How did Daylight Saving Time get started? Daylight Saving Time (DST) had its beginning in Australia in all states & territories during World War I -1917 between 1 January and 25 March (late summer in Australia). It was discontinued after the war, but World War II saw its return for three consecutive summers.

Tasmania may be our smallest state, but they had great influence on why we have DST in Australia today. Their government implemented it in the summer of 1967 to save power which saved water. A severe drought in the state made it imperative that DST be used to help the situation. As it turned out, they liked having DST so much

have continued it ever since. The Tasmanian state government pushed to get DST used Australia-wide.

By 1971 legislation was passed by all states except the Northern Territory and Western Australia to run a trial period. Victoria, New South Wales and South Australia made it permanent in 1972. Currently Queensland, the Northern Territory and Western Australia do not have Daylight Savings.

As aresult, DST has varied at times depending on local issues. For example New South Wales extended DST in 1981-2 because of power shortages. During the Sydney 2000 Olympic Games special Daylight Savings Times were observed by some states, but not all. This lack of uniformity is blamed for the serious problems in scheduling and reduced hours available to work with others across state lines. Daylight Saving Time also means Australia has 5 time zones when in effect. Starts in the southern States on 6th October!
