# **Mobiles Update**

Most probably everyone over 14 years of age has a mobile phone in Twin Waters but do you real know where the service comes from and what has been happening in the area in terms of coverage and upgrades?

Twin Waters is essentially serviced by four Mobile Phone tower facilities. To the south is the facility on the Roof of Banyandah Towers on Bradman Ave; To the west are the Mobile Towers at the old toll booth on the Motorway Exit (one is Telstra, the other Optus). To the north is the Tower at the SunBus Depot at the Airport. To the east is a joint Optus/ Telstra Mobile Tower in amongst Bushland to the rear of the Apex Club.

The most dominant facility in terms of coverage is from the roof of Banyandah Towers mostly due to its height and variety of Spectrum Antenna. Some users might

find that during the day they get varying levels of speed and coverage. Mobile Phone technology is basically "cellular", sort of like a beehive, so as the more demand is placed on a "tower" (surfing the net at night, calls in the car going to work, kids hopping on the internet when they get home from school etc), the signal strength has to compensate and the cell shrinks.

Those closest to the tower will have a more "constant" level of coverage than those further away. In this case, the towers to the North, East and West will then take over and help resolve the problem. As the data and voice demand decreases, the cell then increases.

Over the next 3 months, all 4 Towers servicing Twin Waters will undergo a major upgrade. This will involve a Joint Venture agreement between Optus and Vodafone with the end result being an increase in Vodafone coverage into Twin Waters plus Optus 4G coverage. Actually there are 30 Optus sites from Noosa to Caloundra involved with this upgrade. Recently you might have noticed Optus laying Fibre Optic Cable along Ocean Rd. This was to connect the Twin Waters Resort into the fibre grid. If you have more questions, www.optus.com.au is a useful resource.
