It's Beginning to Look a Lot Like Christmas!

he word "Christmas" comes from the old English "Cristes maesse", or the mass of Christ. It is probably that the Christmas date of December 25 was chosen to offset the Pagan celebrations of Saturnalia and Natalis Invicti. It may also be that the celebration of the birth of the "true light of the world" was set at the time of the December solstice because this is when the days in the northern hemisphere began to have more hours of sunlight. Christmas holiday customs derive from cultures, various including Teutonic, Celtic, Roman, West Asian and Christian.

Symbols

The mistletoe is a commonly used Christmas decoration. Some people believe that any male or female who meet under hanging mistletoe are obliged to kiss. Mistletoe has pagan associations. For example, the Druids of Gaul regarded mistletoe growing on oak trees as sent from heaven.

Other common decorations associated with Christmas

are holly and ivy – both are associated with Pagan festivals as it was customary to decorate with greenery for these festivals.



It All Adds Up!

If you think your child is watching too much TV you might feel better after reading this. Terence Chi-Shen Tao was born in Adelaide in 1975. He was a child prodigy. Much research was done on this exceptionally gifted child. At the age of two, he could carry out basic arithmetic and during a family gathering, Tao attempted to teach a 5-year-old child arithmetic and English. When asked by his father how he knew numbers and letters, he said he learned them from Sesame Street. Aside from English, Tao speaks Cantonese, but cannot write Chinese.

By the age of 9 he was attending university level mathematics courses. He is one of only two children (besides Lenhard Ng) in the history of the Johns Hopkins' Study of Exceptional Talent program to have achieved a score of 700 or greater on the SAT math section while just 8 years old (he scored a 760).

In 1986, 1987, and 1988, Tao was the youngest participant to date in the International Mathematical Olympiad, first competing at the age of ten, winning a bronze, silver, and gold medal respectively. He remains the youngest winner of each of the three medals in the Olympiad's history winning the gold medal when he barely turned thirteen.

At age 14, Tao attended the Research Science Institute. When he was 15 he published his first assistant paper. He received his bachelor's and master's degrees (at the age of 16) from Flinders University.

From 1992 to 1996, Tao was a graduate student at Princeton University, receiving his PhD at the age of 20. He joined the faculty of the University of California in 1996 and at 24 he was promoted to full professor at UCLA and remains the youngest person ever appointed to that rank by the institution.

Tao's parents are first generation immigrants from Hong Kong to Australia. His Dad is a pediatrician, and his mother was a secondary school teacher of mathematics.

Tao's two brothers both have represented Australia at the International Mathematical Olympiad. Nigel Tao is part of the team at Google Australia that created Google Wave. Trevor Tao has a double degree in maths and music.

Tao and his wife Laura (an engineer at NASA's Jet Propulsion Laboratory), their son and daughter live in Los Angeles. Are you feeling better or worse now?
