#### Stockland Decision

tockland's appeal against **O**the Sunshine Coast Council's rejection of their application for a change in the zoning of the Canelands site to allow them to undertake residential development on the site was dismissed in a decision handed down by Judge Rackemann in the Planning & Environment Court on December 13, 2013. Our understanding is that the decision is final and may not be appealed, which would mean that the matter is now closed.

The appeal process, which started in 2009, culminated in a Court Hearing in February 2013. The TWRA was a Co-Respondent with the Council in the appeal. The judgement delivered on 13 December ran to 58 pages and addressed the matters which could not be resolved between the two principal parties, Stockland and Council. Expert witnesses from both parties presented their arguments in Court and were subject to cross-examination and also incisive questioning from Judge Rackemann. The main areas of contention included conflicts with relevant town planning schemes. flooding (and evacuation from the site in the event of severe flooding); land use and proximity to other residential development i.e. Twin Waters, visual amenity, landscape character and need. The onus was on Stockland, as the appellant, to make the case that the appeal should be upheld. In the end, the Judge found that there was not a sufficient need for the development and dismissed the appeal. The land will remain zoned for "rural" uses.

As reported to our TWRA members following the decision, this is a very pleasing outcome for the TWRA and for our Twin Waters community. We should acknowledge that due process was followed; that Council was well represented and the Council's original decision was strongly defended in Court. The fact that the adjacent communities (i.e. Twin Waters) did not want the development also weighed into the decision. Our organised opposition from the outset, including the more than 800 objections, mostly from Twin Waters residents, was a factor in the case directly by our participation as a Co-Respondent and indirectly by keeping Council's "feet to the fire". We express our appreciation for the support from our Divisional Councillors, currently Councillor Jason O'Pray and also our former Councillor, Debbie Blumel.

On behalf of the community, we express our thanks to the Sub-Committee who managed our involvement in the case – Geoff Billard, Peter Braithwaite, Dennis Kyling, Warwick Daniels, Ken Vaughn, Rob Fletcher, Ken Taylor and Ian Landreth. We also thank everyone who provided their initial objections to the Council and those who have maintained their interest and support throughout this lengthy process.

The TWRA's involvement in this case definitely made a difference and is manifest evidence that a strong local community association can achieve good results for the community. #### Taking Care

here were five reported break and enters In Twin Waters reported at Christmas. Houses in Starfish Way, Baywater Drive and three in Oceanic Ct were broken into. Most involved entering through slightly ajar or unlocked sliding doors. Reported thefts included wallets and also cars entered whilst parked in the garage. Subsequently there were also break-ins of cars in Esperance Drive with wallets and keys stolen. So, while we are fortunate with a low crime rate in Twin Waters, it is not a perfect record and we must continue to take care.

#### Crime Map Online

he Queensland Police Service has Introduced a web based system whereby crime statistics can be viewed via the new Crime Map Online facility. Just go to: http://www.police.qld.gov.au where you will find a link to "Crime Map Online". In Part 1, select the Area of your Interest e.g. postcode 4564 and then in Part 2, select a relevant Time Period. It is also possible to gain data concerning Offence Types (in Part 3) and to Analyse Data (in Part 4). This is a worthwhile addition to public crime reporting by Queensland Police.

#### Concerns About the Lake

here have been a number of recent confirmed sightings of shark(s) in the Twin Waters lake. There will probably always be some sharks in the lake and waterways as they would enter when they are juvenile. This is one of the reasons that there are prominent NO SWIMMING signs around the lake. Inquiries made with government departments have told TWRA Committee that bull sharks are not dangerous to humans until they are over 2 metres in length. However, we doubt that the sharks have been told that they are not allowed to bite until they grow up. They are not a protected species. The lake is connected directly to the river by large pipes under the weir. We cannot stop any marine creatures entering the lake. Bull sharks are known to frequent estuarine waters and survive guite well in brackish water. Eventually mature sharks will pose a very real threat to users of the lake and canals.

The lake and waterways are still owned by Lend Lease. They are in the process of being handed over to the Council, but that process seems to be extremely drawn out. It appears we may have to have to wait until the lake handover is completed and then lobby Council to remove the most dangerous sharks. In the meantime, we all have to take care in using the lake and waterways and, in particular, be careful for our children and pets.

#### Valentine's Day

t. Valentine's Day began as a liturgical Ocelebration of one or more early Christian saints named Valentinus. The most popular martyrology associated with Saint Valentine was that he was imprisoned for performing weddings for soldiers who were forbidden to marry and for ministering to Christians, who were persecuted under the Roman Empire. The day was first associated with romantic love in the circle of Geoffrey Chaucer in the High Middle Ages, when the tradition of courtly love flourished. In 18th-century England, it evolved into an occasion in which lovers expressed their love for each other by presenting flowers, offering confectionery, and sending greeting cards (known as "valentines"). Valentine's Day symbols that are used today include the heart-shaped outline, doves, and the figure of the winged Cupid.
