## **President's Report**

At the AGM in August the President said he liked to think that our Association helps to make Twin Waters such a great place to live. He said many of our members personal efforts make a major contribution to the sense of community we have. TWRA continues with the various activities of the Association, the Carols, Birthday Picnic in the Park. Clean Up Australia, Bowls and Golf days, Neighbourhood Watch, Landscape Management and until it was resolved, the Stockland Canelands Development Appeal. The Caneland development was eventually resolved when Stockland's appeal to the Planning & Environment Court was refused by the Judge after a long hearing and an even longer wait for the decision to be announced. This was a great result for our community and Peter thanked all those involved, in particular, Geoff Billard, for their involvement over a long period of time. We must bear in mind that Stockland still owns this land and are free to make further applications to re-develop the property.

We continue to keep a close watch on the Sunshine Coast Airport re-development as the proposed east/west runway will relieve Twin Waters of a lot of aircraft noise. We are represented on the Airport Community Forum which meets on a regular basis. It is expected that the Environmental Impact Statement will be released shortly. Council and the airport management are confident of a 2020 completion date.

Our other activities, the Picnic , the Carols, Bowls and Golf days, Light Up Twin Waters etc. continue to be supported by the community and many of our members contribute to their success. Neighbourhood Watch continues to keep the community informed and encourage residents to look after their and their neighbour's property. Neighbourhood Watch is undergoing a transition to be a more "online" information provider.

Our newsletter is still distributed monthly to all houses in Twin Waters. Dinah McCulloch does a great job as Because of the income from advertisers our newsletter is self-supporting..

Thanks also goes to Cynthia and Malcolm Smith for their organization of the Christmas in July luncheon at Lily's on the Lagoon and also for their efforts with the Entertainment Book which financially assists our Association.

We continue to be supported by a number of generous sponsors. At this stage, Council and Police consider that we do not have a sufficient incidence of hooning to justify a stronger approach such as CCTV, which was being investigated by the TWRA Committee. We will continue to pursue options with the Police that can assist to eliminate this antisocial behaviour.
