### Maroochy Town Centre

Now that the new Maroochy River Golf Club has opened in Bli Bli, and the old Horton Park Golf Club members are relocated, the plans for the Maroochydore City Centre are well and truly underway.

SunCentral Maroochydore Ptv Ltd is the corporation that has been established to oversee the design and delivery of the 53ha parcel of land at Maroochyodre into the new city centre. Construction is planned to commence later in 2015, with plans for retail, residential and commercial developments.

SunCentral will be developed over the next 20 years, transforming Maroochydore into one of the most functional and commercially completive regional cities in Australia.

# Airport Forum

The Airport Forum was held 30 June. Below is a brief report from the TWRA representative Ken Vaughn highlighting key points from the meeting.

- The Air New Zealand season has been extended and will be increased from two flights to three flights per day, on a Friday, Sunday and Tuesday. These flights are tying in with flights from the US and are achieving good passenger numbers. The length of visitor stays has increased and more revenue is going into the community.
- There is a "Fly Local" campaign under way and they are hopeful it will generate more local interest.
- Aircraft and Movement complaints are down, but helicopters still make up the majority of complaints.
- Flying fox dispersals have started again with the aim that the bats don't come back towards the airport from a safety point of view, as a flying fox can cross flight paths. This is being carried out by the council.
- RACQ Careflight has been given a new 30-year lease – everybody is satisfied with the deal.
- The Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) is still under consideration but a decision is not expected before October, but more likely December.
- Councilor Steve Robinson said that the SC Business Council has been looking at capital investment for the region, and have had some strong investor interest, with them preparing to invest in the runway project. Mr Robinson stated that there would be no financial input from ratepayers.

# App of the month

It can take years to learn a new language and even longer to become truly fluent, but sometimes you need a translation of words, phrases, signs or even menu items faster than that. Whether for travel or just out of curiosity the ability to quickly translate a few phrases is extremely helpful. Google Translate make translating languages on the go both fast and easy.

Google Translate is available for both Apple and Android. With a database of over 90 languages you should be able to translate on the go almost anywhere you travel. The app gives you four ways to enter a word or a phrase. The first is by typing a word or phrase directly into the app. If you find a word or phrase that has accents or symbols you can't find in your phone keyboard, you can draw it in with your finger. A lot of times someone says a word to you and you have no idea how to spell it but you remember the pronunciation, with Google Translate you can speak the word into your microphone to the best of your ability and the app will find it for you. The last way is maybe the most useful, it actually allows you to take a photo of a sign or menu item and the app will identify the words and let you know that you're heading the wrong way on a one-way street! Very helpful!



# Magna Carta 800<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

Eight hundred years ago, a 3000-word document was signed that became a foundation for the freedoms we still enjoy today.

This is the Magna Carta which is Latin for the Great Charter. It was signed 800 years ago on 15 June 1215 by King John I of England in a meadow at a place called Runnymede. It was the result of tense negotiations with the King and his discontented barons and bishops. Little did they know that this document, handwritten in medieval Latin on untanned animal skin, would become the cornerstone of English common law. Today the Magna Carta is widely regarded as the greatest constitutional document of all times and the foundation of the international rule of law.

The 800th anniversary of Magna Carta was celebrated in Australia and around the world on Monday, 15 June 2015. As part of the on-going celebrations of Magna Carta in 2015, more events are planned around the world.
