Master Plan 2005 – 2020

In response to the invitation for comments on the Airport draft Master Plan, I support the submission from the Twin Waters Residents' Association.

In particular I support the following:

The draft Master Plan should be rejected and a revised plan should include:

- a) A clear vision statement for Sunshine Coast Airport
 - To meet and foster the tourist and business needs of the Sunshine Coast; and
 - To minimize adverse impacts on Sunshine Coast residents
- b) An immediate priority for the planning and development of an East / West runway to provide
 - A safe runway which is wider and longer than the existing north / south runway
 - Possible re-alignment to provide for maximized approaches and take-offs over water
 - No residential properties to be included within the prescribed Public Safety Zone
- c) The proposal to extend the existing main runway by 200 metres to the north to be abandoned
- d) A "high case" passenger growth forecast based on recent growth rates continuing for at least the next 5-7 years
- e) More consideration to mitigation of the adverse effects of general aviation
