There will be a presentation of the new website at the next TWRA General Meeting to be held on 15 June 2015 and the web site designer from Corporate Design Solutions, will also be in attendance to explain the functionality of the site and answer any technical questions.

The vision is for the new website to become the GO TO site for anything Twin Waters, keeping residents and visitors alike up to date with information and local news. The website will continue to evolve over time and has the capacity to grow and develop as more uses and functions that are appropriate for a community website are found.

A staged approach to the development of the website has been taken, with the initial stage being to set up the new website and have the basic functions established, and the inclusion of current and relevant information and documentation of historical information. Later, enhancements such as an online trades directory, membership renewals, event management (e.g. dine outs or golf days etc.) and also a buy/sell/swap section will be considered.

Further Canelands Discussions & Progress

Stockland and TWRA representatives met with the Sunshine Coast Mayor, councilors and senior council officers on 13 May to provide a briefing on discussions to date and to consider a possible forward pathway and timeline. The Mayor welcomed the paradigm shift from Stockland to engage in wide community consultations regarding the future of the Canelands. The new concept plan with a lake and canals, premium waterfront lots and average lot sizes similar to Twin Waters, together with amenity features to enhance the entire Twin Waters area were all viewed as positive. Our strong concern for alternative traffic access was noted and some options are being examined and viewed positively. Most of all, our requirement to have any agreed conditions "locked in" regardless of who owns the land were understood and accepted by Council and a legal mechanism to do this was proposed by Council. There is still a lengthy process (circa 12 months) to undertake for the land to be re-zoned and there will be more opportunities for public consultations and submissions to Council during this period. Stockland reiterated their intention to continue to consult with our community as the process moves forward.

By the way, if you would like to be kept fully up-to-date on developments in relation to the Canelands, we strongly suggest you join the TWRA (if you are not already a member). TWRA members are kept advised by email as soon as possible after any relevant discussions with Stockland and / or Council.

Residents will be aware that a meeting was held recently at Mudjimba to oppose the proposed Airport Expansion Project and specifically the proposed East-West runway development. As you know, the TWRA and this community has long supported the proposed runway development and we have been active and constructive in involvement over many years. We continue to support it because of the jobs and tourism opportunities it will create for the entire Sunshine Coast region. We are concerned that the Mudjimba meeting was not representative of the wider community and that its views may be misrepresented as having more support than is actually the case. The new organisation, ResDev, has taken ideas and actions from the Sekisui campaign at Yaroomba and we can therefore expect to hear and see more from them. We consider that it is very important that public discussion on key development issues, including the Airport Development Project, be based on facts which are material to the issue and that all participants be fully informed. Some allegations were aired at that meeting which relate to the facts around the Project EIS. We are taking steps to confirm the facts and to also see whether they are material in relation to the whole project. We consider that it is important to maintain focus on the big picture - the Airport Expansion Project is essential for the economic future of the Sunshine Coast and we will continue to support it.

Queen's Birthday Holiday

The Queens Birthday holiday is a much-anticipated long weekend for many Australians. This year the Queen's Birthday holiday falls on Monday 8 June in all Australian states and territories except WA, which celebrates on Monday 28 September.

Did you know that the Queens actual birthday is 21 April? So why is Queen's birthday celebrated in June and not April? In Britain, the monarch's birthday has been celebrated since 1748 and in Australia, every year since the First Fleet arrived in 1788. Traditionally it was always celebrated on the actual date of the monarch's birthday until 1936, the year of the death of King George V, Queen Elizabeth's grandfather. His birthday was 3 June and the date of celebration of the monarch birthday has stayed around early June ever since.

However there will be a change of date for the Queen's Birthday public holiday in Queensland for 2016. The Queensland Government has announced that in 2016 the Queen's Birthday will be celebrated on the first Monday in October. These changes will only be finalised once the Queensland Government Treasurer approves the new date.

Mobile Library

There are two mobile libraries servicing the Sunshine Coast region. The mobile libraries allow library services to be offered to the greater community and to those who may not be able to make the trip to their local library. Each mobile library has staff on hand to assist with borrowing, renewing, sourcing and returning items. While not offering the same range of materials as the community libraries, the mobile libraries do offer an online reservation service. This means you can browse the library catalogue online, place a hold on the items you would like to borrow, nominate your collection location and pick them up when the mobile library next visits. Items can be returned to the mobile library at its next visit, or to any of the other branches in the region.

The Sunshine Coast Library mobile library visits Twin Waters on a fortnightly basis. The library stop is on Ocean Drive outside the shopping village every second Tuesday between 1100-1230. June dates are scheduled for 2 June, June 16 and June 30.

Have you ever been out and about spotted an animal and wondered what it was? If you have a smart phone there is an app that can help you with this. The Queensland Museum Network Field Guide to Queensland Fauna App describes over 560 species of birds, fishes, frogs, lizards, snakes, mammals, turtles, freshwater, marine and terrestrial invertebrates, spiders and insects including butterflies.

Full of detailed descriptions of each animal, maps of their distribution and endangered species status combined with images the app is a valuable, easily used, portable reference tool. Owing to the diverse nature of habits and large number species found in Queensland the scientist at the Queensland Museum will be continually adding new species to the app.

The app is available for Apple users from the App Store and for those with Android phones, you can get it on Google Play.
