Fiona Simpson MP and divisional councillor Debbie Blumel were also on hand to help bury the time capsule in honour of the State's sesquicentennial anniversary.

Residents contributed content ideas, the burial site was coordinated with Council and more than 30 items were collected and preserved for the future residents to unearth.

Contents include the latest Living in Twin Waters brochure, a letter from TWRA President, current editions of local newspapers, local shop and housing price lists and the development history and pictures of the area.

The future residents of Twin Waters will undoubtedly enjoy discovering what life was like in 2009 and understand just how much, or little, the lifestyle and environment have changed.

More than 300 residents enjoyed the fun in the sun during the afternoon celebrations which included free activities and entertainment for the kids, a fund-raising sausage sizzle to support the Mudjimba Surf Club and music by 'The Blue Notes'. Wildlife Management Near Airport

Sunshine Coast Airport is implementing a formal Wildlife Management Plan for the Airport to monitor and reduce the risk of bird strikes for aircraft using the airport. Fortunately, SCA has a relatively low number of bird strikes per annum, with an average of 8 to 10 per year.



On a comparative statistical basis, this puts us in the lowest quartile of Australian airports. Airport management wants to keep it low and the Management Plan is being developed and implemented.

What's the Name of the Area?



As everyone knows, Stockland is attempting to get approvals for the development of the land west of Twin Waters to the Motorway. Over many years, this land has been known as the Canelands. Stockland has been calling this land Twin Waters West, which has obvious benefits for them for marketing purposes. There is strong local opposition to this development. The SCRC has rejected (unanimously) Stockland's DA and the matter is being appealed to the State Planning & Environment Court. We consider that the land should still be called the Canelands and we will continue to use this name for the area until something else causes us to change. The TWRA is a Co-respondent in the appeal over the development of the Canelands and we will keep you advised of progress.

Bike Path from Bridge to Twin Waters



The Government and the Council have agreed on the route for construction of the "Missing Link" in the Bikeway from the Maroochy River Bridge to David Low Way and Twin Waters. It will go on the eastern side of the Motorway up to David Low Way. Construction could commence in the first half of next year. This is welcomed news for bike riders (and walkers).
