This month the signs went up on the Twin Waters West development site advising all that the public consultation period has begun.

The public has until 29 September to 'have their say' to Sunshine Coast Council about the proposal by developer, Stockland to create 450 housing lots on the land running parallel with the Sunshine Coast Motorway. The Twin Waters West development is the biggest change to our community since the establishment of the Twin Waters suburb in the late 1990s. We encourage everyone to take an interest and tell the Council what they think.

New Look Development for Pacific Paradise Preview!

TWRA President Sophie and new Management Committee member, Richard Matlof were given a preview of what's planned for the area beside the North Shore Tavern and on the area of the former Bowls Club – now dormant since before Covid.



The development is the idea of the current Northshore Tavern owners, John Goulter and David Wheldon, who claim the proposed apartments in particular will be a major contribution to the current accommodation crisis for many service industry workers.

Media reports have already noted though that some of the buildings, which range from 3 to 6 stories, are 7.75 metres taller than current height limits.
